Wet Earth Technologies operates fully permitted hydro excavation waste disposal and recycling facilities in Los Angeles. We receive non-hazardous slurry from hydro-excavation trucks, vacuum trucks, and roll-off bins — processing it through augers, shakers, and screens to separate reusable aggregate and recycled water. 95% of all waste is recycled back into the Southern California economy. Nothing goes to landfill. Open 24/7.

PROCESS OVERVIEW

How We Recycle Hydro Excavation Waste



Recycled output: aggregate grades & reclaimed water



Stanford Transfer Facility — Los Angeles

1 Receive

Slurry delivered by hydrovac truck, vacuum truck, or roll-off bin

2 Separate

Pumped through augers, shakers & screens — aggregate sorted, water into weir tank

3 Reclaim

Aggregate blended to construction spec; water centrifuged for re-use

4 Return

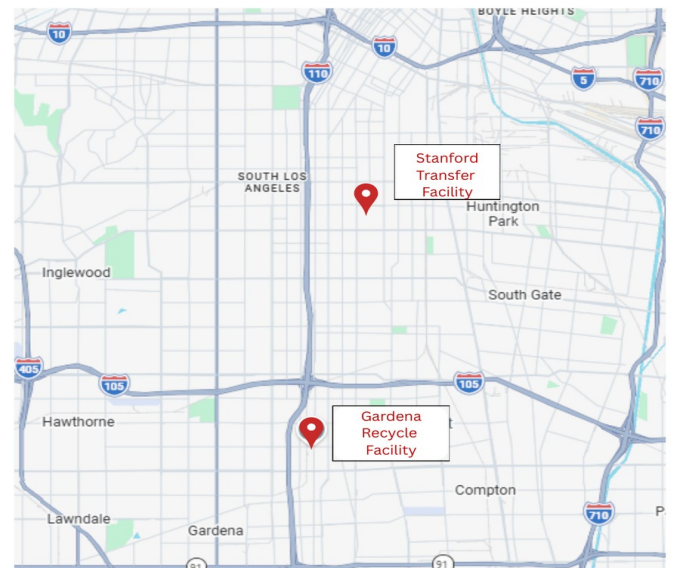
Recycled materials re-enter the SoCal economy — zero landfill
